SWITZERLAND. "FALSE PROMISES AND PERSONAL ATTACKS¹".
Your Brussels Press Conference of 15.02.2018.

Dear Mr. President,

I was not surprised bad sad, and sorry to discover that you too have determined that **the Swiss establishment and its captive and tightly controlled media have been misleading and profiling the president of the E. Commission since his taking office in 2014**. You probably have also experienced that there have always been half open windows of opportunity and purveyors of hope conveying the ever-imminent conclusion of the Framework Agreement etc in the ever near future. You understand that the Swiss merely intended to keep you inactive till the end of your term. Any loss of face on the behalf of the president of the E. Commission being an inner political bonus. If unchecked the Swiss will subject any future presidents of the E. Commission to exactly the same treatment.

There are 1,347,095 EU MS Nationals in CH (Status 31/12/2016). The **freedom of movement and residence² right** is the only tangible result to the vast majority of MS nationals. In Switzerland, instead of "**Acquis communautaire³**" they experience institutional exploitation, discrimination, extremely limited access to training and no **advancement⁴** (viz. 70 - 80%⁵ of the hiring takes place unadvertised - much of it within the Swiss Militia). The rare reports of blatant violations of the BA-I that reach the Swiss Media disappear from the newspaper sites (thanks to the current morphing of APF500⁶) within hours⁷.

Within Switzerland, there is no Constitutional Court to which one might appeal injustice, unfair practice, maltreatment, and professional exclusion^{8,9}. The Judges themselves are politically appointed part-timers and it is not unheard of, that the Justice of the peace presiding over an employment dispute works part time for the employer involved. Outside Switzerland, the Bilateral Agreements BA-I with the EU do not provide for an independent tribunal that an affected EU MS national can access¹⁰. Like in the Iran Nuclear deal, **the European Commission itself is merely a "facilitator"** not party to the Bilateral Agreements and individual Member States have invariably much "higher" priorities¹¹ (viz. multibillion sums in tax evasion, money laundering, secret bank accounts, trade imbalances etc.) to resolve with the Swiss administration than the fate and assets of individuals or groups. What was supposed to be a transitional period solution has become the preferred modus operandi in the BA. This enforces the need for a Framework Agreement that somehow incorporates the CURIA¹². The CH-EU Joint Committee is about barter between MS and CH not justice.

Dear Mr. President, if the Swiss can subject the Commissions' President to false promises and personal attacks you may imagine what they do to individual MS nationals. Exactly like yourself, they too get half promises for amiable resolutions that never materialise and years later they come to both conclusion and certainty that these promises have never been sincere. They were intended to please, appease^{13,14}, and put off counteractions for as long as such might be possible. In our case even the rare written official **pledge**¹⁵ on **matters of national importance**¹⁶ from the highest administrative authority¹⁷ in CH falls under the term "**Communication**" and proves worthless, non-binding, and not to be followed with promised **action(s)**¹⁸. Even when capable to mobilise the official representation of our MS this proves of no use as they¹⁹, too, get to be at Ambassador Level ignored²⁰.

and feel certain you will find it accurate, pertinent, and commensurate to your own experience.

The www.elvetia.org exposition reflects the aggregates of: a) 17 years of legal residency in CH²¹; b) another 3+ years with a fully owned Credit Swiss subsidiary in the UK; c) ample "cool-down time" and physical distance, and d) the macroeconomic viewpoint possible following over ten years' experience as Assistant to Ministers and senior positions in the ministries of Finance and Development. It has been on the Internet for many years and communicated to the appropriate Swiss authorities over and over again without any reaction.

Sixty-six percent (66%) of the foreign nationals or 1,387,000 out of 2,101,100 (Status 31/12/2016) are EU/EFTA nationals. Following the signing and ratification of the Bilateral Agreements BA-I with the EU in 1999 & 2002 even major EU Member States who have dealt with invited foreign nationals themselves have delegated the control of the well-being of their own nationals²² together with associated monetary interests to the **EEAS (European External Action Service)**.

The EEAS is known to field only **two (2) permanent employees** on the control of all seven (7) dossiers encompassing the BA-I²³, representing a worth in excess of €350 Billion/yr.? **Alone on the free movement of Persons Dossier the two EEAS employees are matched by a well-funded army of Swiss uniformed and civilian officers.** On the Federal level, the officials overseeing the **SPFWC** are housed in a **secure building**, the "Federal Office of Migration²⁴", near Bern that constitutes a major section of the Federal Justice and Police Department^{25,26}. The 200-400 Bern based federal migration officers are augmented by significant organizations in the 24 Cantons²⁷ as well as every city²⁸ and community administering the documentation and the processing of foreign nationals.

I hereby ask you for a relevant meeting at your convenience. I offer my considerable first-hand experience in that country, the deep relevant understanding of its structures and ways to the E. Commission on the control of the implementation of the BA-1.

I also ask you for the EC's assistance in validating and disseminating the contents of the www.elvetia.org to future generations of MS nationals potentially at risk. No expatriate can survive institutional Discrimination. Institutional policies can only be countered by well-funded institutions.
