

## EU INSTITUTIONS VS MS NATIONAL STAKEHOLDERS

1 On at least two occasions the Commission announced the firm intention, and finally  
2 concluded “flagged” treaties: A) the Bilateral Agreements affecting hundreds of  
3 thousands of MS nationals and trillions of Euros in trade & services with a third State  
4 (CH)<sup>i,iii,z</sup>, and B) Wide ranging MS Memoranda (GR) and has failed to control the  
5 signatory’s compliance as well as enable formal access to MS stakeholders.

- 6 1) **Systemic failure to Act<sup>iii,iv,v,vi</sup> and Control<sup>vii</sup>** the implementation of the afore  
7 mentioned treaties.
- 8 2) **Systemic failure to provide for access & independent resolution**  
9 **mechanism(s)<sup>viii</sup>** for MS stakeholders.
- 10 3) **Repeated attempts to cover up** the state of affairs (Communication  
11 Exercises) by EC services to both Stakeholders<sup>ix</sup> and EP members<sup>x,xi</sup>.
- 12 4) **Lack of informant Protection** within, let alone, outside the EC<sup>xii</sup> despite  
13 flagged precedent case histories.
- 14 5) **Systemic practice of terminating<sup>xiii</sup> interaction** with MS Stakeholders and  
15 EP members if dressing up, playing for time<sup>xiv</sup>, and massive Communication  
16 Exercises up to EP level<sup>xv</sup> fail to wear them down<sup>xvi</sup>.
- 17 6) Etc.

18 In both cases, following reports of foul play<sup>xvii</sup>,<sup>1</sup> by contracting parties, the relevant  
19 Commission services attempted to ignore pertinent facts and implementation  
20 shortcomings. Upon failure to “wishy wash”, instead of offering a bona fide  
21 resolution avenue Commission services chose to “agree to disagree”, play for time<sup>xviii</sup>,  
22 and/or terminate correspondence.
